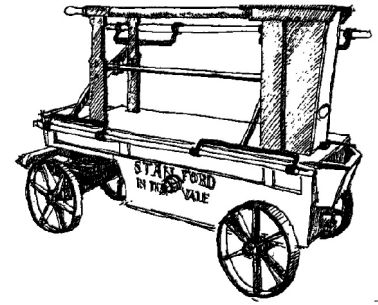

LIBRARY RULES

- 1 In these Rules the term “book” is taken to mean a book, leaflet, map, CD, or any other library item.
- 2 A book labelled “NOT FOR LOAN” is only available for consultation at the library and may not be taken away.
- 3 Books may be borrowed by any paid-up member of the Society.
- 4 Books will normally be loaned for a period of four weeks. This period may be renewed on request to the Librarian.
- 5 A Member will normally be allowed to borrow only one book at a time. At the discretion of the Librarian this may be extended to a small number of books in a series or on a common theme.
- 6 Copyright law applies to all books, i.e. copying for reproduction in any form of any part of the book will require the prior written permission of the copyright owner (normally the author), except in the case of copying of small sections of the book by Society members for personal research purposes only.
- 7 Borrowers will be responsible for the safe-keeping and return of books. The Society may charge for any damage, loss or failure to return.
